

Three Dimensions may, from time to time, modify this Customer Privacy Policy to reflect legal, technological and other developments. In that event, the changes will appear at this location.

How we collect information about you

When you visit the Three Dimensions website, we collect your IP address and standard web log information, such as your browser type and the pages you accessed on our website.

If you open an account, we collect the following types of information from you:

Contact information - your name, address, phone, email and other similar information.

We request personal information when you register for an event, correspond with us or engage in certain other activities on our Web site. For example:

1. If you register for an event on-line with us, we will ask you for information necessary to complete the transaction - such as your name, address, and credit card number.
2. If you request assistance by e-mail, we will ask you for information necessary to complete the transaction - such as your name, address, event information and the nature of the problem you are experiencing.

You make the decision whether to proceed with any activity that requests personal information. If you do not wish to provide the requested information, however, you may not be able to complete the transaction.

We will never request your password, user name, credit card information or other personal information through email. This practice, called "phishing", is a scam designed to steal your personal information. If you receive an email that looks like it is from us asking you for your personal information, do not respond.

How we protect and store personal information

Throughout this policy, we use the term "personal information" to describe information that can be associated with a specific person and can be used to identify that person. We do not consider personal information to include information that does not identify a specific individual.

We store and process your personal information on our computers in the US, and we protect it by maintaining physical, electronic and procedural safeguards. We use computer safeguards such as firewalls and data encryption and we authorize access to personal information only for those employees who require it to fulfill their job responsibilities.

We work to protect the security of your information during transmission by using Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) software, which encrypts information you input. Should you use a credit card for payment, only the last four to five digits of your credit card numbers are revealed to us when confirming an order. Of course, the entire credit card number is transmitted to the appropriate credit card company during your payment processing.

Financial information provided by you for event registration is not distributed to any persons not associated with the event planner, registration data entry and event financial management. Credit card details are encrypted and not retained by the event planner, registration data entry or registration onsite cashiers. Only the information necessary to confirm payments or credits for accounting records is maintained in the event database.

It is important for you to protect against unauthorized access to your password and to your computer. Be sure to sign off when finished using a shared computer.

How we use the personal information we collect

Our primary purpose in collecting personal information is to provide you with a safe, smooth, efficient, and customized experience. We may use your personal information to:

1. Provide the services and customer support you request;
2. Process transactions and send notices about your transactions
3. Resolve disputes, collect fees, and troubleshoot problems;
4. Prevent potentially prohibited or illegal activities;
5. Customize, measure, and improve our services;
6. Customize, measure, and improve the content and layout of our website;
7. Send you event related service update notices;
8. Compare information for accuracy and verify it with third parties.

Personal information provided for the event is not distributed to any persons not associated with the event planner, registration data entry and event management personnel.

How we share personal information with other parties

Third-Party Service Providers: We employ other companies and individuals to perform functions on our behalf. Examples include processing credit card payments, registration tracking and providing customer service. They have access to personal information needed to perform their functions, but may not use it for other purposes.

How you can restrict Three Dimensions from sharing your personal information

You may choose:

1. Not to provide personal information, although that may result in your inability to obtain certain services or use certain features of our website;

2. To stop receiving emails or conference information letters from us by sending an email to the contact address at the bottom of this policy;
3. To delete or decline cookies by changing your browser settings, although if you do so, some of the features or services of our website may not function properly;
4. To review and update your personal information by contacting us at the email address below.

How you can access or change your personal information

You can review your personal information and make any necessary changes, at any time by logging in to your account and changing your preferences in the “My Profile” page of the event registration login page.
